Jadot Couvent des Jacobins Pinot Noir

Made at the historic Chateau des Jacques winery, this bottle is a tasty intro to Pinot Noirs from the Burgundy region, combining elegance, heritage, and modern winemaking with amazing versatility.

Pillar & Post Sonoma Coast Chardonnay

From a well-known Napa winery. Bright orchard fruits on the palate and refreshing acidity make this an excellent spring food wine.

Bon Vivant Rosé

California sparkling wine made in the French style. Made from Chardonnay and Pinot Noir grapes which give it a crisp, elegant taste.

2019 Cantina Valle Isarco Pinot Grigio

The key here is Isarco Valley's microclimate in the northernmost wine-producing area of Alto Adige. Hot days and cool nights create grapes with elegant balance, complex citrus and honeydew flavors, and mouthwatering acidity.

2018 Remoissenet Beaujolais Fleurie

Crafted by Remoissenet and Domaine Julien Clément. The microclimate in their organic vineyards creates beautiful Gamay grapes with natural acidity and depth.

Château D'Aigueville Côtes Du Rhône Rosé

Thanks to the exceptional terroir where it grows, this rosé is powerful on the palate yet smooth and balanced on the finish! It's one rosé that can stand up to heartier grilled foods like steak and burgers.

2019 Château Croix Mouton Red Bordeaux

Forward-styled, easy-to-like, crowd-pleasing Bordeaux—enjoy it while it's "young" to get the most from its ripe fruit and charm. Great with hearty fish, pasta, and grilled meats.

The perfect introduction to Chardonnay from the Burgundy region. This bottle combines elegance, heritage, and modern winemaking. It is made at the historic Chateau des Jacques using sustainable viticulture to help preserve the environment.

Conde Bel Reserva

Traditional Rioja blend of Tempranillo for elegance, Garnacha for fruitiness, and Mazuelo for freshness. Flavors of cherry, plum, blueberry, vanilla, sage, thyme, and cocoa. Full bodied with velvety tannins.

2019 Chateau Haut Bellian White Bordeaux

Born in vineyards located between the famous Garonne and Dordogne rivers, in the heart of Bordeaux. The soil of sand, limestone, and seashell deposits produces wines with vivacity and freshness. Excellent with chicken, seafood, and lighter fare.

Bixby Creek Bridge Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon
