

# Our Summer TOP 20 WINES

## 1 Château Marsau Red Bordeaux

Château Marsau's vineyards benefit from an excellent microclimate which allows their wines to reveal their most expressive and distinctive character. An amazing value that drinks better than many wines twice its price.



## 2 Philibert Ducard Montmains Premier Cru White Burgundy

Chardonnay is the only grape grown in the Chablis region, as it thrives in the cool climate and claylimestone soils found there. This Premier Cru wine reflects its terroir deliciously.



## 3 Periodic California Pinot Noir

Rich and decadent with bright, juicy berry notes leading to a silky and lasting finish.



## 4 Stationmaster Alexander Valley Cabernet Sauvignon

Shows its Alexander Valley, California roots with intense black fruit flavors, good acidity, and gravelly notes on a bed of fine-grained tannins.



## 5 Golden Gate Cellars Sonoma Coast Chardonnay

From one of the top Sonoma growers. This coastal climate—with warm days, cool nights—is perfect for producing buttery, delicious Chardonnays.



## 6 Alex Chaumeau Sancerre

This is the first time in over a decade this Sancerre has been offered in the United States. It is rich, elegant, and has the classic minerality finish that makes Sancerre such a delight! Pair this with shellfish, grilled chicken or a light summer salad.



## 7 Latour Pinot Noir Cuvée Latour

This special Bourgogne Pinot Noir comes from the Côte d'Or vineyards of Marsannay, Santenay, and Auxey-Duresses, where the vines average over 30 years old. The limestone, clay, and granite soils give this value wine plenty of character for the price.



## 8 Torraiolo Chianti Classico Riserva

It's not easy to find a Chianti Classico Riserva of this quality at this price! From our favorite producer in Tuscany, this wine boasts dark fruit with hints of violet and mocha, a soft mouthfeel, and a long, lasting finish.



## 9 Glacial Till Riesling

A treat from one of our favorite producers in the Finger Lakes, this Riesling sings with ripe cantaloupe, passion fruit, sweet citrus, and apricot on the nose, with a refreshing minerality on the finish.



## 10 The Secret Willamette Valley Pinot Noir

A true steal! 100% Pinot Noir from the Yamhill-Carlton AVA in Oregon's famed Willamette Valley. Red raspberry, cherry, and cranberry dominate the nose and palate, while the precise and balanced finish is complex and layered.



## 11 Villamont Crémant de Bourgogne Rosé

Our friends at Henri de Villamont produce this Crémant using the same method as Champagne. A great party starter and complement to almost any appetizer, it's well-balanced and packed with fruit—a real treat for wine lovers.



## 12 Hitch Edna Valley Chardonnay

From the iconic Edna Valley comes this Chardonnay with aromas of white flowers, citrus, melon, and hints of orchard fruit and pear. The nose carries on to the palate with bright acidity, notes of oak, and a long finish.



## 13 Chateau de Ribebon Red Bordeaux

One of the best values in Bordeaux, this blend is made in collaboration with Michel Rolland, who grew up at Château Le Bon Pasteur and has worked with more than 150 wineries on four continents, including Bond, Harlan, Ornellaia, Clinet, and Angelus!



## 14 Tolan Garnacha

This brilliant wine comes from the oldest clone of Garnacha in the world. Savor the complex dark fruit notes interwoven with velvety tannins and a silky finish.



## 15 Château Gabaron White Bordeaux

A unique white Bordeaux featuring Sauvignon Blanc and Sémillon grapes, Gabaron's vineyards sit smack-dab between the famous Garonne and Dordogne rivers. The soil there is made up of sand, limestone, and seashell deposits, giving this blend a captivating freshness and vivacity. Perfect for lighter summer fare.



## 16 Detective Cabernet Syrah

This cuvée was blended with the best plots of each of its varietals in order to achieve the ideal combination of quality and maturity. Take part in the investigation yourself, and discover vibrant aromas, exquisite Mediterranean notes, and fruit-forward flavors.



## 17 Pierre Moulin Chardonnay

The vineyards that produce this white from Pierre Moulin are just a few miles from the Mediterranean Sea. Grapes from each vineyard are gently pressed and fermented separately at low temperatures to create more freshness, finesse, and purity. A perfect summer sipper!



## 18 Famiglie Pinot Grigio

This delicious summer white from our favorite Italian producer features aromas of pear and apple on the nose, while the palate bursts with mouthwatering acidity!



## 19 Homestead Collection H3 Cabernet Sauvignon

This Cabernet from the Mercer family shows the full potential of Washington's Horse Heaven Hills region! Aromas of ripe red fruit and cranberries mix with hints of brown sugar and sweet baking spice, while powdery tannins give it both structure and elegance.



## 20 Paua Rock

With mouthwatering acidity plus gooseberry, grapefruit, passion fruit, and white peach flavors, this prime example of New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc is a perfect match for shellfish such as oysters and New Zealand's "paua."
