1 Under The Tuscan Sun

This expressive red rewards wine lovers with a perfumed aroma and a delicious palate with notes of dark red fruits, well-integrated oak, and a long, elegant finish. A classic Super Tuscan blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and Syrah, it's a steal at this price point!



2 2015 Chateau De Braude Red Bordeaux

This Cru Bourgeois from the Haut-Médoc is run by the Bernaleau family, whose deep roots in the Margaux region show in this red blend. A must try, its silky texture and elegance make this a classic 2015 vintage Bordeaux!




3 Moving North Pinot Noir

The Willamette Valley has proven to be an ideal location for producing premium wines for over 50 years. Moving North is a blend from vineyards all over the Valley, demonstrating the flavors, aromas, and textures for which it's revered. It's a perfect pairing with salmon and chicken dishes.



4 Pierre Ponnelle Saint-Véran

One of the great figures of 19th century Burgundy, Pierre Ponnelle is credited with developing most modern oenological techniques. 150 years later, his wines showcase their roots in the purest Burgundy tradition.



5 Koenig Gewurtzraminer Vin d'Alsace

This French Alsatian white wine is the perfect marriage of old and new winemaking techniques. The result is a rich and complex wine that is elegant and food friendly, especially with Asian cuisine.



6 Homestead Red Blend

Horse Heaven Hills is one of our favorite Washington regions, great for high-quality red wines that drink well above their retail price point. This red blend features ripe plum, sage, a smoky sweetness, and vanilla, which give way to a balanced, silky midpalate.



7 Golden Gate Cellars Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir

This delicious California Pinot Noir features enticing aromas of blueberry and blackberry, with notes of black tea leaping from the glass. The ripe plum flavors are accented by orange peel and hints of cardamom, with a slight touch of minerality.



8Rodney Strong Sonoma Chardonnay

of Rod Strong, a pioneer in Sonoma County winemaking, this crisp Chardonnay features bright citrus characteristics with hints of tropical fruit and toasty oak followed by a clean finish.



9 Parini Prosecco Brut

Start any celebration off right with the effervescent Parini Prosecco. Made by the historic House of Lamberti in the Veneto region of northern Italy, you'll love its versatility and refreshing spirit of fun.



10 Latour Valmoissine Pinot Noir Les Terrasses

Les Terrasses vineyard's consistent southern exposure guarantees sunshine and cool nights during the summer, which helps the grapes reach perfect maturity. Like the Grand Crus of Corton, the result is an elegant wine with remarkable finesse.

12 Golden Gate Cellars Rutherford Cabernet Sauvignon

This full-bodied wine opens with a bouquet of blackberries, baking spices, and sweet tobacco on the nose. Its beautiful structure is deftly balanced with layers of dark fruit. Enjoy this wonderful example of California's signature varietal with a grilled ribeye steak or braised beef short ribs.



13 Tramin T Biance

You'll love this youthful white blend of Chardonnay, Pinot Blanc, and Sauvignon Blanc. It's perfect as an apéritif, or you can pair it confidently with light courses such as vegetables or fish. Perfectly balanced, each sip leaves you craving another one.



14 Bixby Creek Cabernet Sauvignon
